List of Species Available for Planting

All memorial and tribute donations are recognized in a gift book in the Visitor Center and published in the Institute's newsletter, *Naturally Speaking*. With gifts of \$250 or more, you may be able to choose a native shrub or plant to add to the *Celebration Garden*. Species available for planting are:

Shrubs:

New Jersey tea (*Ceanothus americanus*)
Lead plant (*Amrpha canescens*)
American hazelnut (*Corylus americana*)
Shrubby cinquefoil (*Potentilla fruticosa*)

Grasses:

Little bluestem (*Schizachyrium scoparium*)
Oats grama (*Bouteloua curtipedula*)

Wildflowers:

Rattlesnake master (*Eryngium yuccifolium*)
Butterfly weed (*Asclepias tuberosa*)
Wild bergamot (*Monarda fistulosa*)
Black-eyed Susan (*Rudbeckia hirta*)
Blue vervain (*Verbena hastata*)
Pale purple coneflower (*Echinacea pallida*)
